We are pleased to offer the **2020 Calgary Chef's Association Apprenticeship Scholarship – Sponsored by Sysco Calgary!**

The Scholarship covers up to **\$1,100.00** (one-thousand one hundred dollars) per year, for a **maximum of three years**. This Scholarship is designed to cover the costs of tuition and modules for each period, to a **maximum of three Young Chef Members** in good standing, as they complete **The Red Seal Cook Apprenticeship Program** at the **Southern Alberta Institute of Technology (SAIT)**.

The **2020 – 2022 Calgary Chef's Association Apprenticeship Scholarship – Sponsored by Sysco Calgary**, will be awarded at the end of each year of apprenticeship, with proof of completion letter, for up to 3 years.

To be eligible for the **2020 – 2022 Calgary Chef's Association Apprenticeship Scholarship – Sponsored by Sysco – Calgary**, you must have completed the following criteria.

Written Essay

The applicant must submit a minimum of **500 word written essay** indicating why they believe they are the right candidate for the **2020 – 2022 Calgary Chef's Association Apprenticeship Scholarship – Sponsored by Sysco Calgary** as well as **3 letters of recommendation** from employers or instructors.

Volunteer

The applicant must volunteer at minimum 3 Calgary Chef's Association functions or charities we support. Including a major charity ball (when applicable).

Cooking Competition

The applicant must have competed in the High School Skills Hot Food Competition for a minimum of 1 year.

Professional Resume

The applicant must have an up-to-date resume with a minimum of 3 professional work-related references.

The Board of Directors will read through each applicant and choose the **three High School Students** we will be awarded the opportunity for the **2020 – 2022 Calgary Chef's Association Apprenticeship Scholarship – Sponsored by Sysco Calgary**.

Deadline to Submit: Friday, January 31, 2020 at 5:00pm MST

Scholarship Announced: President's Ball – Golden Whisk Awards (Thursday, May 14, 2020)

To maintain your **2020 – 2022 Calgary Chef's Association Apprenticeship Scholarship – Sponsored by Sysco Calgary** for the proceeding years you must complete the following criteria.

Volunteer

The applicant must **volunteer at minimum 3** Calgary Chef's Association functions or charities we support. Including a major charity ball (when applicable).

Cooking Competition

The applicant must compete in a minimum of **2 competitions** a year.

Grade Point Average

The applicant must maintain an **80% GPA or higher** each year across all modules to be eligible. As well as be enrolled for their next period of academic classes at SAIT.

Applicants must have completed all of the pre-requisites to be considered for the 2020 – 2022 Calgary Chef's Association Apprenticeship Scholarship – Sponsored by Sysco Calgary. Please ensure that you have reached out to your Culinary Teacher to assist you with the process.
